On behalf of Taekwondo Victoria Inc, it is my pleasure to invite you and your club to participate in the Victorian Moomba Open Taekwondo Championships on Saturday 10th March at the State Netball and Hockey Centre, Brens Drive, Parkville.

This is a sparring and poomsae tournament for colour and black belt competitors of all ages: Junior, Open and Masters divisions. Athletes will be required to be registered as Sports Athletes with Taekwondo Australia and all Victorian athletes must be financial in regards to any monies owed to TVI.

In Poomsae it is a "One on One" competition. Black Belt competitors may choose to enter either the A grade or B grade competition. A grade competitors are eligible for Taekwondo Australia point system (TAPS). For Sparring competitors TAPS points are only available for the 14-17 and Open divisions.

Please also be aware that all athletes must bring their **signed** confirmation of entry form from the online entry process as well as photo identification, to the Registration Desk in order to be permitted access to the tournament.

Competition entries close on Wednesday 7th March, 2012 at midnight. Please Note: as the online system is fully automated, no late entries can be processed after this date.

All entries are to be submitted on the Online system at www.tkdvic.com or www.peopleinaction.net.au (follow the links).

Due to the short lead-up time for this, our first tournament of 2012, I would like to encourage our judges and coaches to be proactive in contacting their respective co-ordinators to assist in organising for this event. NOTE: Multiple events can include entering more than one division in sparring, (Black Belt only) or entering a sparring and a poomsae event. The maximum number of events is therefore limited to three.

- Eligible Competitors:** To be eligible to contest the Victorian Moomba Open Championships athletes must:
- be a registered sports member of Taekwondo Australia Inc 2012
 - have at all times acted in a proper manner and not have engaged in any conduct that would bring the Association, our sport or any of our staff into disrepute or censure.
- Registration:** All competitors MUST bring their current 2012 Taekwondo Australia registration card and signed competitors entry confirmation form from online registration (signed by Head Instructor) on the competition day. Players without registration cards and forms will not be permitted to compete.
- Age Divisions:** All competitors ages are **as at 31st December, 2012** unless otherwise stated
- Competition Schedule:** **Saturday 10th March, 2012 (indicative only)**
- POOMSAE**
Officials and Judges arrive 7.00am - Judges meeting 7.15am
All belts registration at 7.30am - Competition Starts 8.00am to 1.00pm
- SPARRING**
Officials and Judges arrive 9.00am - Referee – Coaches meeting 9.15am
Interstate and Regional Victoria competitors weigh in at 9.00am
TAPS competition starts 10.00am - Competition starts at 12.00 Noon
- Liability:** All participants in the tournament take part at their own risk. The organisers can under no circumstances be held responsible for any damages, injuries, or loss to individuals or equipment.
- Spectator Prices:** **Single: \$10 Family: \$25 Children under 6: Free**
- Refunds:** All attempts will be made to match all entrants. Uncontested players will receive a refund or they can request a medal. Competitors seeking refund due to injury or illness must submit a doctor's certificate for consideration. Applications must be received in writing within 7 days after the competition of the competition. POOMSAE COMPETITION

Divisions: Black belts may choose to enter the A grade competition which qualifies them for TAPS points. The A grade format will follow a knockout system, but, to guarantee all players at least 2 patterns we will apply a repechage system and award medals for the repechage champion. Black Belts may enter either the A Grade or B Grade event.

For B grade competitors the division will be not more than 4 players. Players will be matched on the day. Some divisions may be combined due to insufficient entries in a particular division.

Final divisions will be decided once all applications have been received. In the event of an uncontested competitor, the competitor may choose to enter another division, compete alone (thus winning 1st place), or ask for a full refund.

Awards: For the A Grade competition, medals will be awarded to first, second and third place. A medal will also be awarded to the winner of the repechage competition. For the B Grade event, all competitors will receive an award.

Tournament Rules: Two players compete at the same time. Judges will award a winner based on majority decision at the end of the match. The winner progresses to the next round. In A Grade, losers in first round will all progress to the “repechage” round. In the B Grade and colour belt events, winners play off for first and second, losers play off for third and fourth.

Judging based on the following criteria: First “accuracy”, then “power”, then “expression of Ki”, then “best artistic impression”.

SPARRING COMPETITION

- Draw** Single Elimination or Repechage System, depending on number of Entries.
- Weigh In** Competitors weigh-in will be conducted on Friday 9th March 2012 from 5.00pm at the State Netball & Hockey Centre, Brens Drive, Parkville.
- Regional and Inter-State members can weigh in on the morning of the competition (TAPS event players from 9.00am – 9.30am, other players from 9.30am – 10.00am).
NOTE – this weigh in is ONLY for Regional and Interstate members!
- Please Note – Juniors that are not within 1.00kg of weight will be given the opportunity to move up one weight division. They will NOT be permitted to re-weigh for their chosen division. This decision has been made due to duty of care issues and State Junior policy regarding developing children.
- Please also note: the following must be presented at the weigh-in:
- Signed Competitors Entry confirmation from on line registration (signed by Head Instructor)
 - Competitor's Sports Taekwondo Australia membership card with photo ID
 - Minimum acceptable dress during weigh in is T shirt and shorts with a 0.5kg allowance
- Tournament Rules** WTF Competition Rules – please note, these rules may be adjusted – details will follow. No Head Kicks for NOVICES and Yellow Belts, regardless of age. Also no head kicks for Junior Divisions, ie – 8-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15 years.
- Age Groups** All ages are taken as from the 31 December, 2012. The minimum age for competitors is 8 years. 8-9 years, 10-11 years, 12-13 years, 14-15 years, 14 -17 years (TAPS, Head Kicks), Open (15 +) (TAPS, Head Kicks), 31 – 40 years, 41 – 50 years

- Match duration may be altered subject to competition time constraints!**
- Protective Equipment** Competitors must provide and wear WTF approved protective equipment (head protector, mouth guard [clear or white], arm guards, shin guards, groin guard – males [females optional], hand gloves, foot gloves and body protector). All 14-17 and Open Black Belt (TAPS divisions), will be required to have DAEDO foot gloves. The DAEDO body protectors will be provided.
- Daedo foot gloves can be purchased through DAEDO Australia ([refer information sheet, attached below](#)).
- No Damaged Equipment will be allowed – there will be no variation to these rules!**
- Awards** All events will recognise first, second, and third placing with Gold, Silver and Bronze medals. If a competitor is in a final match uncontested they will win a gold medal.
- Competition Draw** A full list of competitors will be posted on the internet prior to the competition at www.tkdvic.com. Copies of the draw will be available in a PDF download format on the people in action website.

1. *Weight and age categories may vary depending on the number of participants. **It will be at the discretion of the Tournament Organising Committee to add, alter, delete or amalgamate weight and age divisions depending on registration numbers.***
2. *Taekwondo Australia Limited registered members are required to bring their Taekwondo Australia Card for identification, currency of membership and insurance verification.*
3. *Competitors weigh-in will be conducted as per the above.*
4. *Competitors are required to wear the standard white dobok (white pants, white top and belt according to their level).*
5. *Any REFUNDS must be applied for according to the documentation mentioned above under 'Refunds'. ALL documentation without any exemption must be submitted immediately after the tournament which will allow orderly and timely process to take place.
